Setting Up Your AspireBox

Before powering your AspireBox on, make sure your TV is turned on and the HDMI port to be used by the Aspire Box is the active one.

The AspireBox is an actively updated, self-maintaining system. It is designed to remain powered on for best performance.

Using The GyroRemote/Keypad

The GyroRemote/Keypad serves as a navigation and input device for the AspireBox.

The most unusual feature for most users is activating and using the Gyro-Mouse function.

To access this feature:

- ❖ Press the mouse icon at the bottom center of the remote.
- ❖ A triangular mouse will appear on the screen.
- ❖ Move the mouse with hand motions until it is atop a desired option
- ❖ Press the “OK” button to select the option.
- ❖ To leave Gyro-Mouse mode, press the “Down” area of the click ring that surrounds the OK button.

Connecting To A Wireless Network

- ❖ Select the Add-on browser tile.
- ❖ A submenu will appear, select Programs.
- ❖ A set of tiles will appear in the PROGRAMS menu, select OSMC.
- ❖ Click down once to select the network icon (looks like a triangle with circles at each end).
- ❖ Click down once, click OK, then over 3 times to select your network. Click OK when its highlighted.
- ❖ Confirm that you want to connect to that network by clicking “Yes”.
- ❖ Enter your network password and click OK.

If it doesn't connect the first time, repeat

Navigating Kodi

The AspireBox uses the Titan Kodi Skin, for easiest navigation. There are 7 tiles available:

- ❖ Videos
- ❖ Music
- ❖ Pictures
- ❖ YouTube
- ❖ Weather
- ❖ Add-on Browser
- ❖ Settings

Below the tiles is a power icon. Arrowing down to that area opens menu bar with options for:

- ❖ Settings
- ❖ Quit (Advanced Feature)
- ❖ Power Off System
- ❖ Reboot

Accessing the AspireBox Dashboard:

The AspireBox utilizes Multicast Universal Plug and Play (UPnP) network protocols, and a protocol known as 'Zeroconf' that enable browsing to its built-in dashboard at:

Zeroconf is enabled by default on your AspireBox.

Preferred web browsers for this function are Chrome, FireFox or Safari. The Microsoft Internet Explorer and Edge browsers are not recommended.

If you are using a Microsoft Windows based computer to access the AspireBox, please install the Apple Bonjour print server available at:

If you are unable to access the AspireBox dashboard, you'll need to perform make some adjustments to your home network:

- ❖ Enable Multicast On Your Router:
- ❖ Access methods vary among the different brands of router on the market, refer to the user's manual to access your device.
- ❖ Multicast and UPnP configuration will usually be found in the advanced setting area of the router configuration site.
- ❖ Locate the entries for both of these settings and enable them.
